DREF - Anticipated Unmet Needs

The State of Missouri received more than 230 applications for funding in excess of \$250,000,000 for our PL-110-329 appropriation. This is nearly two and one half times the state's awarded grant amount. To date we have awarded 55,230,947 that are detailed in DRGR, with another \$25,071,500 committed and in process of executed grants. There are applications currently in our review and development process that will exceed the remaining Supplemental Appropriation and will be awarded based on competitive scoring.

Missouri is proposing to dedicate \$5M of funding to access a dollar for dollar match of \$5M more in DREF funds. The funds will be offered using a request for proposals or notice of fund availability method of distribution. Applicants will be evaluated on need, impact, and local effort. The State of Missouri has a significant amount of land mass residing in the 100 year and 500 year floodplain, as defined by the Federal Emergency Management Agency FIRM maps. Historically, the state developed using the river network (Missouri River and Mississippi River and their tributaries) as a transportation network to ship goods to the west. As such, communities developed and grew along those rivers and tributaries. That growth has contributed to flooding events that impact the health, safety and well-being of Missourian&rsquos. Loss of life and loss of homes, businesses, personal property and the devastation to real property has burdened the state during significant, widespread flooding events. Between 1990 and 2009, Missouri recorded more than 90 deaths due to flash and riverine flooding. Proof of that widespread damaging capacity came in the form of a Presidential disaster declaration for 106 of the 114 total counties in the State in 2008. Missouri is home to 977 cities, towns and villages in those 114 counties.

Since the floods of 1993, Missouri has created and implemented an aggressive buyout of properties in the floodplain and we have realized substantial savings as a result. More than 1000 properties have been purchased and deed restricted in perpetuity to open space activities in the last decade and one half. Those properties will never again receive a National Flood Insurance Program payment. They will never subject a resident to danger or experience damage to a structure. The program can be called a success. However, FEMA estimates that more than 216,000 households are within designated floodplains in Missouri. To date, in the short period between the notice of available DREF funding, we have identified 5 more communities that are prepared to support more buyout activities. There are more eligible properties, more willing communities, and more families deserving of a decent, safe and sanitary comparable home, outside of the floodplain. Many of these communities will use CDBG funds to match FEMA Hazard Mitigation funding but there are additional, smaller river communities that are not eligible for FEMA funds, that our efforts could support, as well.

Even with the buyout activities, Missouri&rsquos communities will always be linked to the rivers. Their future, their viability and in many cases their economic activity is still linked to the waterways. It is for that reason, that access to fundingland use pltate resource available in Missouri for planning activities. We have regional planning commissions, councils of government, and federally designated economic development districts. Those service providers assist with economic development strategic planning, redevelopment planning and planning related to specific projects. There is however, a gap in a community&rsquos access to real land use planning.

Some mitigation efforts in Missouri have been driven by need as a response to an event. Land use planning will give many communities an opportunity to address that next step of development or redevelopment through a systematic analysis of land assets that derives efficient uses of land. A forward thinking land use plan will include views of the many facets of land use and the many impacts including the environment, society, and the local economy.

Areas of Greatest Need

>The Consolidated Security, Disaster Assistance, and Continuing Appropriations Act (PL-110-329 and hereafter identified as the Second 2008 Act) appropriates over \$6 billion in CDBG funds for necessary expenses related to disaster relief, long-term recovery, and restoration of infrastructure, housing and economic revitalization in areas affected by hurricanes, flooding and other natural disasters that occurred during 2008. The allocation awarded to Missouri from this Supplemental Appropriation is \$92,605,490. There were six separate Presidentiallydeclared Disasters in Missouri during 2008. At least 3,892 homes were affected by weather related events in 2008, with 1,839 being affected, 1,488 sustaining minor damage, 320 sustaining major damage, and 245 being destroyed. At least 22 levees were affected by the flood; total estimated repair cost is \$36,139,000. U.S. Army Corps of Engineers funding will address the bulk of this; CDBG funding from the regular state program and from the First Supplemental Disaster Appropriation have assisted several communities in providing match for Corps funding. A portion of these levees are being addressed with existing CDBG funds, but total assistance needed by local governments and levee districts greatly exceeds existing funding.

At least two communities in northeast Missouri have reported businesses affected to the extent that buyout and relocation of these businesses is desired. Widespread damage to public infrastructure has been reported by communities and regional planning commissions.

The federal disaster declarations that are relevant to this supplemental appropriation are 1742, 1748, 1749, 1760, 1773, and 1809, and areas eligible for assistance are indicated on the FEMA website for the six declared disasters. All counties marked as designated during any 2008 disaster, as well as the cities within those designated counties, are eligible to apply for these supplemental funds. Areas not eligible for this funding include Benton, Caldwell, Clay, Clinton, DeKalb, Henry, Jackson and Lafayette counties.

Projects related to disaster relief, long-term recovery and restoration of infrastructure, housing and economic revitalization in areas affected by the declared disasters are prioritized as the areas of Greatest Need.

>These supplemental disaster CDBG funds may not be used for activities reimbursable by or for which funds are made available by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) or the Army Corps of Engineers. Further, none of these supplemental disaster CDBG funds may be used as the required match, share, or contribution for another federal program. The supplemental appropriation will have no specific set-asides for individual application categories. All applications will be evaluated on the criteria listed in the Application Evaluation section of the HUD-approved Action Plan. The total supplemental appropriationis\$92,605,490.Nolessthan\$10,372,631mustbeused foraffordablerental housing. The maximumamount thatwillbeusedfor administration(bothstateandlocal)is\$4,630,274.Projectsrelatedtodisaster relief,longtermrecoveryandrestorationofinfrastructure, housing and economic revitalization in areas affected by presidentially declared disasters in 2008 are eligible for this funding. Proposed water or wastewater projects must still participate in the Missouri Water and Wastewater Review Committee process unless the proposed project is limited to direct disaster recovery.

Project Dates and Duration of Assistance, Locations/Responsible Organizations

>Projects being undertaken as part of this supplemental appropriation will follow the same guidelines for project period as the state&rsquos regular non-entitlement CDBG allocation. All Grantees are local governments that will have 24 months from the time of award to expend and close-out the project.

Amendment #2 to second Disaster Supplemental Action Plan

On December 31st, 2010 a tornado struck Lambert Airport in St. Louis and the surrounding neighborhoods and businesses in St. Louis City and County causing significant damage to homes and businesses in the area.

On May 22, 2011 an EF-5, multi-vortex tornado struck the heart of Joplin, Duquene and parts of Jasper and Newton Counties, leaving a six mile long and one mile wide path of destruction to homes, businesses, and infrastructure forever changing the fabric of this community and region. The tornado caused a tragic loss of life with current related deaths at 155, which is higher than any death toll from a tornado in 50 years. There are a large number of individuals still hospitalized from the tornado, many fighting to survive.

On May 25th, 2011 a tornado struck Pettis County causing damage to a mobile home park, businesses and school property.

Each of these tornados has caused damage to the housing and the economic infrastructure of the communities. Although the current impacts are not directly related to the damage suffered in 2008, each has unmet needs from 2008. Through this amendment, these communities may access CDBG, under the eligible categories and eligible activities listed in this Plan, to address these current and unmet needs.

Amendment #2 to second Disaster Supplemental Action Plan

Unmet Need from 2008

>Already reeling from multiple weather related events in 2008, the region had suffered previous loss of homes and businesses through tornados and flooding from which they had not recovered. Multiple Presidential disaster declarations were made as a result of the repeated damaging weather in 2008. In addition, 2010-2011 Tornado events have exacerbated needs in some areas. The state is proposing to allocate \$27,000,000 to allow communities affected by tornadoes in 2010 and 2011 to access 2008 Disaster Supplemental funds to address housing and economic revitalization needs that were exacerbated by the 2010/2011 events, or otherwise meet unmet needs from 2008. While specific detailed grantee activities are still being determined, housing and business lending and demolition activities are expected to comprise all of the reserved amount. Initial estimate of business lending is being allocated at \$3,000,000. The \$3,000,000 is set up as a project in the action plan, and the remaining \$24,000,000 is set up as a project until specific housing and other activities are identified. 2008 Disaster Declarations in Missouri:

Overall Progress Narrative:

Mexico DI-01: Closeout monitoring held, with no findings. Awaiting closeout paperwork from grantee. >New Madrid County DI-02: Project complete and has been closed out.

>St. Louis County DI-03: In support of Lambert St. Louis International Airport, we continue to implement Aerostrata&rsquos recommendations to aggressively reach out to freight forwarders to secure export backhaul commitments and communicate air cargo opportunities to carriers around the globe. Our grant is budgeted entirely towards planning. We have used 62% of our budget.

>Dixon DI-04: The City has completed construction of the new roadway. The City needs to complete the Section 504/ADA Self Evaluation, conduct a public hearing, and schedule the close-out monitoring. MRPC staff met with the City Clerk to emphasize the need for the City to complete the Section 504-ADA Self Evaluation. The close-out hearing is scheduled for Nov. 4 CDBG monitored this project on 12/4/13 and all outstanding items have now been submitted. Grant administrator is working on the close-out packet.

>Eminence DI-05: Sitework has been completed. The project has been monitored and the closeout documents are being prepared.

>Macon County DI-06: Work began on County Bridge 32200201 (Walnut Creek Township) on October 22, 2012 and has been halted several times this quarter due to weather. Certified payrolls are being submitted and reviewed for compliance. 100% of the rehabilitation work has been completed by contractor Bleigh Construction. The structure is approximately 258&rsquo in length with a width of approximately 24&rsquo. Total contract award for the project is \$987,808.90 which includes BRO participation. The County and contractor are working to resolve some issues involved with concrete used on the structure, thus a Certificate of Completion has not been issued by the engineer. > Maryville DI-07: Closed

>Montgomery County DI-08: Street: 0% complete. MODOT is in the design phase of the project and is completing the environmental review. Property acquisition will begin as soon as the environmental report is complete. Administration: 10% complete. No administrative fees have been requested.

>Nodaway County DI-10: Bridge: 85% Complete. During this period, January 1 to March 31, 2014, the County of



Nodaway advertised for bridge materials for H-Pile and Re-Bar to construct a new single span Steel 1 Girder bridge 80&rsquo in length by the county&rsquos road and bridge crew. Bids were opened on February 7, 2014 and the low bidders were selected. The county received the MODNR demolition notification on March 20, 2014 and demolition began March 21, 2014 on the old bridge. The construction of the new bridge began March 24, 2014. This Bridge, #0055003 located in Atchison Township, Nodaway County, Missouri. Administration: 70% complete. No administration costs were requested this period. Administration performed this period included the procurement for bids and administrative paperwork.

>Pulaski County DI-11: Bridge: The bridge deck is 55% poured out; next two weeks should see more concrete deck being poured. Expect that the deck will be poured out by April 30. Still finishing steel plating of selected members and replacing corred sections. That work is about 65% completed. The efflorescense has been sandblasted from the concrete substructure, patching of spalled concrete on the substructure is 75% done. The north abutment wingwall has been replaced and the south rock retaining wall has been rebuilt. The north truss concrete has cured and is tested good for the painters to set up their equipment for containment. They started that yesterday and should start removal of rust and flaking paint next week. They will follow right on the heels of the deck pour. Engineering Design: No worth this quarter-engineering design is complete. Construction Inspection: Great Rivers continues to provide construction inspection services for the County. Great Rivers provided status updates and picture of on-going work as requested. Administration: Meramec RPC continues to provide grant administration services for the County. MRPC assisted the county with completing the section 504/ADA self-evaluation, reviewed contractor payroll records, and prepared RFF #4. MRPC attended a meeting 3/27/14 with the county clerk, engineering firm, and MODOT review the project funding plan/payments made to date/plan for future payments.

Savannah DI-12: Drainage: Construction is 90% completed. There has been no activity during the first quarter. Currently waiting on weather/ground conditions to accommodate completion of this task. (Soil is frozen. Remaining task involves dirt work and trenching.) A contract amendment was submitted in late 2013 reallocating \$4,500 from Other Professional Services to Drainage. Engineering Design: 100% complete. Construction Inspection: Ongoing. There has been limited movement during the first quarter due to weather conditions. This activity is 85% completed. We anticipate this being finalized with the completion of Activity 13-Drainage. Administration: Ongoing. Limited progress took place in the first quarter. The task is 75% complete. Currently working with city to complete the close-out monitoring session. We anticipate this being finalized at the conclusion of project. >Schuyler County DI-13: Bridge: 100% completed July 2013. Administration: Close out meeting held, all monitoring items completed and accepted. RFF 01-2014 and 02-2014 requested final funds, project closed 3/21/2014.

>Scotland County DI-14: Bridge: 0% complete. This project was funded to replace county bridge #159 and construct bridge at low water crossing #375. National disaster declaration has slowed all progress throughout county. Engineering plans/specifications still under review by MoDOT. Waiting on easement authorization from one owner at each site. No activity to report this quarter. Administration: Approx. 25% complete. No administrative activity to report this quarter. Other Professional Services: 100% complete. Construction Inspection: 0% complete. Engineering plans/specifications still under review by MoDOT. Waiting on easement authorization form one owner at each site. No activity to report this quarter.

>Jefferson City DI-15: Administration&mdashReview of invoices and payrolls, submitting payments, attending preconstruction meetings and rprts. EIFS complete using tenting and propane measures. Construction site activity impacted by severity of winter conditions. Drywall, taping and insulation install in progress. Interior Rough-In work continues. HVAC is done. Water main extension is complete. Windows and canopy installation has begun. Family Workforce Centers of America (FWCA), child care operator, names center Early Explorers&mdashChild Development Academy. Received LCRA Board Authorization to procure classroom and office furniture, from Community Playthings and KI respectively, on February 19th. Interior painting has begun. Installation of acoustin ceiling and light fixtures in progress. All doors and frames, with the exception of the main entrance, have been installed. Finish grading in progress. Playground berms have been formed. Will begin work on bio retention ponds soon. Parking lot has been graded and ready for asphalt. All exterior sidewalks have been poured. In the process of obtaining Missouri American Water approval to tap into water line. Classroom and office furniture have been ordered. FWCA have intitated their search for a child care center director. Led Annie E. Casey and Kellogg Foundation on site tour on March 28th. Overall construction progress approximately





73%. Administration: Participated in construction progress meetings and site walkthroughs. Reviewed change orders. Reviewed pay applications for lien waivers, certified payrolls, percent completion, and retainage. Requested additional information from the GC to resolved wage rate discrepancies. Reviewed restitution payments. Conducted subcontractor employee interviews. Met with CDBG staff to discuss labor standards and compliance monitoring.

>St. Genevieve County DI-18: Port Facility: Work is 100% complete. The engineer is working with Great Lakes on differences in amount of dredge material brought out of the harbor. When this is resolved the final payment will be made. Administration: Work is 99% complete. SEMO RPC continues to do the required reporting and requesting of funds for the project. All required information has been submitted to James with the only remaining item left to submit is the final RFF. Construction Inspection: Work is 100% complete. The engineer is currently working with Great Lakes on coming to an agreement on the final amount of dredge material. Engineering Design: Work is 100% complete. All design work has been completed.

>Cass County DI-20: Planning additional training curriculum for remainder of grant. Project monitoring was conducted on February 14 with DED and MCC.

>Franklin County &ndash DI-1:nbsp; Project is complete. Remaining funds were expended this quarter. Closeout paperwork is in process and accomplishments have been recorded.

>Greene County &ndash DI-22: Project is complete. Closeout paperwork is in process.

>Grundy County &ndash DI-23: Trainees are enrolled in Agriculture/Natural Resource curriculum courses, and are progressing through the program. Curriculum development continues in the Alternative Energy/Bio Fuels Program.
>Jefferson County &ndash DI-24: Closeout monitoring has been conducted and closeout documentation is in process.

>Newton County &ndash DI-25: Project is complete and administratively closed. Final paperwork and project accomplishments have been reported.

>Pettis County &ndash DI-26: Curriculum development for all programs is complete. Remaining funds have been drawn, monitoring completed and close out in progress. Expected closeout in the April-June quarter.

>Randolph County &ndash DI-27: Accelerated Nursing program, Certified Phlebotomy, and Certified Nurse Assistant courses continue.

>St. Charles County &ndash DI-28: St. Charles Community College signed an agreement with Lindenwood University to lease approximately 26,000 sq. ft of their building&rsquos space for its Associate Degree Nursing Programs. There is a new location for all Nursing and Allied Health programs and partnerships with area businesses have been developed. Students are progressing through the nursing and healthcare courses.

>St. Francois County &ndash DI-29: Project is complete. Closeout paperwork is in process.

>St. Louis City &ndash DI-30: Developing shorter &ldquowork shop&rdquo versions of Aerospace training.

Developing new hands-on projects for composites fabrication and assembly.

>Perryville DI-31: Project completed and closed out. 329 confirmed jobs.

>Belton DI-32: Have received all 36 Certificates of Occupancy and all 36 homes are leased. Project completed and closed out.

>Moberly DI-33: Project completed and closed out.

>Harrisonville DI-34: Project closed. There are a total of 42 units; for a total of 40 Low-income; 2 moderate income and 21 Female Head of Household. There are a total of 38 white households, 3 black/African American households, and 1 American Indian/Alaskan Native & White household.

>Eldon DI-36: Project is complete and has been closed out.

>Crawford County DI-37: Rehabilitation is complete and project is closed out.

>St. Louis DI-38: Property is 100% leased and construction complete as of March 2013. The project is complete and closeout forms are in process. Closeout process is anticipated complete in April-June quarter 2014.

>Brashear DI-39: 8 apartments in 4 duplex units were completed April 1, 2012. Total of occupied units is now five (5). No activity this quarter. Currently taking applications for three (3) units. Contacted local public school staff in Knox County and Adair County, informed them of availability; entertained at least 15 phone inquiries about availability; mailed requested application packet to 3 inquires (no response); listed availability/empty apartments on ATSU website the end of January 2014.

>St. Louis DI-40: 100% complete. Occupancy permits and certificates of substantial completion have been issued for all 51 units. Move-ins have occurred for all 51 units. All funds in this ctegry have been drawn.

>Osage County DI-42: Rehab is complete at all properties. A closeout public hearing was held November 14, 2013. Final review complete Decembe 4, 2013. The County is currently procuring an auditor for a Program Audit and will submit and amendment to move funds to this line item. Close-out packet is being prepared and will be submitted with final draw request, including audit. Project is 100% complete.

>Pulaski County DI-43: One house removed from the program in January at the request of the property owner, who had previously completed all required repairs. During this period four units were completed. Construction rehab has



begun on five units. Completion Status: Administration 60.8% complete, Housing Rehab 13.7% complete, Housing/Lead Inspections 50% complete, Professional Services 100% complete and Asbestos 100% complete. >St. Louis County DI-44: \$232,000 has been expended to date for an 88% completion of grant funds. The St. Louis Economic Development Partnership received approval from the Department of Economic Development to use the \$30,500 of the remaining CDBG funds form the original Chrysler Grant for an Advanced Manufacturing study. The St. Louis Economic Development Partnership developed a scope of services, issued a Request for Proposals, selected a consultant and received the completed study on Mary 17, 2014. It is expected that the remaining funds (\$30,500), with approval from DED, will be expended in the 2nd Quarter of 2014.

>Bellefontaine Neighbors DI-45: Three monthly construction meetings have been held (January, February & March), the last on 3/26. Contractor is 98% complete by scheduled \$\$\$ value of the project. Contract Change (Change Order) 2 for the revised Federal Wage Determination MO130056 and Contract Change 3 to add the abatement & demolition of the Hauptmann and Dietary buildings are pending. We anticipate issuing CC #3 by mid April. As of the end of March the project status is as follows: All asbestos and other abatement work has been completed in the Phase 1 buildings (thirteen each 1500s/1700s Group Homes, Doctor&rsquos Duplex, Kiel and Administration), as well as the phase 2 buildings (Fernald, Wallace, Pinchitters and Elliott); all Phase 1 building and incidental site demolition work has been completed, except for demo work at the Elliott Building, which was just started at the end of March; and the majority of incidental site grading has been completed in the Phase 1 and Phase 2 demolition areas. In summary 20 of 20 Phase 1 and 4 Phase 2 buildings have been completely abated and 19 of 20 have been completely demolished. Finish grading, seeding and mulching will occur in April. DED previously approved (in 3rd Quarter 2013) FMDC&rsquos request to include the abatement/demolition of the Hauptmann and Dietary buildings under the exiting demolition project (M1001-04) as a change order, with the understanding that we will be able to secure a fair and reasonable price from Premier Demolition, the general contractor. Last Quarter, FMDC, with their environmental consultant (Barr/SCI), prepared the Hauptmann & Dietary design documents, which were issued via a Request for Proposal (RFP #4) package on 11/15. The Contractor submitted their proposal (on 12/17) with both \$\$\$ and time significantly higher than ou estmate. This quarter we have reduced the scope of work and obtained a special DNR beneficial use exemption approval on 3/20, both of which have had a major impact on reducing the cost and time. FMDC continues its review of Premier&rsquos &Idquorevised&rdquo proposal, in order to obtain a fair and reasonable price to abate/demolish the Hauptmann and Dietary building. Anticipate final negotiation of the Contractor&rsquos pricing and the issuance of Contract Change #3 by mid April.

>Houston DI-46: Closeout paperwork is being prepared and should be submitted by the end of January. >Cuba DI-48: The additional scope item to install an inlet riser on the water tank has been bid. Contract has been awarded to Ozark Applicators. A pre-con meeting will be scheduled in the near future. This portion of the project was delayed due to the City&rsquos engineer being off work due to injury. Water Distribution: The tower contractor has installed and tested the inlet riser pipe. They need to still insulate the pipe and finish the doghouse. The City is having issues with the well producing muddy water and is not using the well at this time. They are going to camera the well to determine if there is an obvious location to isolate to remove the mud from the well. This will take some time and testing. The City has not installed the fence. Engineering Design: Engineering firm inspected the work for the inlet riser pipe and signed off on a contractor&rsquos pay application for 50% of work completed. Administration: MRPC reviewed payroll reports and is preparing the next CDBG RFF.

>Pettis County DI-49: Our crew was trained and we began commercial operations. We have had some difficulties which prevent continuous operation. After trouble shooting we found the primary cause to be the biogas pipeline between our site and the landfill. The gas is too wet and excessive condensate is preventing the proper amount of gas flow. The landfill is working on corrective measures.

>Canton DI-50: There was no money drawn down on the grant for this quarter. Public hearing held 12/27/2013. Awaiting close-out.

>Platte County DI-51: There has been a change since applying for the grant. Funds are pending.

>Audrain DI-52: Scope of Work Activities &ndash 100% complete; Floodplain critical infrastructure mapping &ndash complete; Locating/mapping emergency sirens &ndash complete and distributed; Mark Twain Lake inundation study &ndash complete and distributed. Using remaining funds to match Structures Inventory project as approved by Andy Papen. Inventory project underway and nearing completion.

>Buchanan County DI-53: Mo-Kan submitted an electronic copy of the &ldquoBuilding a Resilient Community-Disaster Mitigation and Recovery Plan Through Land Use Planning&rdquo to Missouri Department of Economic Development on September 27, 2013. Mo-Kan submitted a hard copy of the &ldquoBuilding a Resilient Community-Disaster Mitigation and Recovery Plan Through Land Use Planning&rdquo to Missouri Department of Economic Development on October 8, 2013. Although the grant ended September-2013, additional internal expenses were incurred in wrapping of the process. These expenses did not affect the overall budget. Mo-Kan&rsquos planning activities are complete and re waiting for the program to be closed out.

>Butler County DI-54: The final report is 100% complete. All project reports and maps have been printed. The final



meetings were held with all 5 counties. All CDBG closeout paperwork was submitted.

>Callaway County DI-55: Technical Assistance and Administration: We continued providing technical assistance to Callaway County EMD and County Commission in using GIS tools to assist with emergency planning operations. Follow-up meetings held with Callaway County GIS Working Group. At the request of Callaway County Commission&mdashwe are in the process of providing projected flood impact per Missouri River flood elevations in the Mokane area. Staff research and report to Mid-MO Board on use of social media during disasters by local governments and others during disasters. Village of Wooldridge Buy-out: Staff provided technical assistance of possible funding options for buy-out of structures within flood-prone areas. Mid-Mo staff is discussing the removal of 3 commercial vacated unsafe structures with City officials. Educational and Training Workshops: Staff continued with follow-up meetings with planning participants of the Continuity of Operations Planning program. Hosted Rob O&rsquoBrien from Joplin Chamber of Commerce, who provided insight to preparation activities community leaders should implement prior to a disaster at January Mid-Mo RPC meeting. Storm Ready Communities: Staff continued with follow-up communication with counties applying for the Storm Ready program. At present, Callaway, Cole and Cooper counties are designated as Storm Ready. Integration of Program Outcomes: During this period, Mid-MO RPC Staff continued to integrate disaster planning issues and strategies into the planning documents of the Mid-Missouri RPC.

>Cedar County DI-56: Work over the past quarter has been focused on the Land Use Study being conducted in Vernon County. Stakeholder interviews were held during March with public meetings to obtain input and current land uses in the area. Work has continued with the region&rsquos siren mapping and research has been conducted with USDA and SCOCOG on how to formulate a region wide siren program as a proposed outcome of the planning project. Proposed final planning report date of completion for this planning project has been identified as October 1st. 2014. No administration is allowed under this grant.

>Greene County DI-57: This project involved three main activity phases including database development, model construction, and model output/final report. Database development is completed for the counties. All phases completed for Taney County. Model construction approximately 75% completed during the quarter for Christian county. Also includes incorporating Community Viz software into the model. Model construction, including stakeholder meeting, completed for Lawrence County and model output/final report approximately 80% complete. Model construction of Barry, Dade, Dallas, Polk, Stone and Webster counties approximately 70% complete. Stakeholder meetings scheduled for emaining counties in April and early May with model output/final reports to be completed during May and early June. Mapping: Low water crossing field inventory and mapping completed for Barry, Dalas, Lwrence and Stone counties. Inventory and mapping approximately 80% completed for Barry, Dalas, Lwrence and Stone counties. Inventory and mapping approximately 80% completed for Dade County during the quarter. Taney County inventory will be conducted and completed during April. Low water crossing inventories already developed for Christian, Greene and Webster counties to be reviewed during April-May for any possible changes (i.e. crossing improvement completed.) General sinkhole mapping completed. Critical infrastructure inventory completed and mapping 90% completed during quarter.

>Grundy County DI-58: At this time, all plans are complete and currently being distributed. All remaining funds (\$4,039.26) will be used as match for our GIS Structures contract in the next quarter.

>Howell County DI-59: In the past quarter, we have finalized all site visits to communities participating in the stormwater management plans. We have completed the draft plans for each of the ten communities and have begun the process of printing and distribution of the plans. Additionally, we have finalized the Siren Mapping project and have begun the printing and distribution for that planning document. SCOCOG staff and the local stakeholders continue to work with USDA Rural Development to obtain funding for warning system needs indentified through the planning process. During this quarter we have also obtained and submitted all match documentation form the grantee Howell County.

>Jasper County DI-60: Staff at the Harry S. Truman Coordinating Council completed the planning document and submitted it o DED this quarter. Final billing has been submitted and completed for the project. JSTCC staff anticipates the closeout process to begin in the next quarter.

>Johnson County DI-61: Attained CDBG approval for a 6 month project extension in order to conduct a site survey for the city of Holden&rsquos Business Park as part of the city&rsquos Certified Site effort. The city of Holden&rsquos wastewater treatment plant is located adjacent to this site. Mitigation alternatives related to possible natural disasters will be explored once the survey is completed. The new CDBG contract end date is June 2014. An MOA between Pioneer Trails RPC and the city of Holden has been executed as part of the project. Completed RFP for survey work. Advertisement of the RFP has yet to take place.

>Laclede County DI-62: LOCLG has completed all themmapping activites in regard to both the Critical Facilities and the Community Anchor Institutions for all four counties, Camden, Laclede, Miller and Morgan. LOCLG has completed the Laclede County Hazard Mitigation Plan and waiting a final approval of the plan to be formally adopted by Laclede County.

>Nodaway County DI-63: The project is still on-going. Funds were requested in October in the amount of



\$7,471.30. At total of \$17,628.49 remains. A second grant extension was approved in November 2013 since the MSDIS project is still on-going and this Disaster project is being used as in-kind match. The anticipated closing date is March 15, 2014. NWMORCOG staff have been working to complete the MSDIS project which was also extended. The first round of Community Anchor Institutions (CAI) data was submitted to MSDIS in November. They have requested additional information which the RCOG is currently gathering for them. A closeout public heaing will be scheduled in February and the final quarterly report and closeout report will be submitted in early March 2014. >Perry County DI-64: This project is 100% complete. All monitoring items were mailed to DED on February 26, 2014. Closeout packet, final RFF #9 and final guarterly report was also mailed to DED. Project outlined six objectives of this project: Technical assistance and/or planning for land utilization in high hazard areas; localized mapping as it related to communities and modified flood zones and decertified levees; technical assistance for completing benefit-cost analysis for hazard mitigation funding; professional development training for local community leaders; indentification, mapping and mitigation planning for critical infrastructure; integration of program outcomes with various state and federal agencies. We have completed a number of projects with theses six objectives in mind. These include: Tornado Siren Assessment of entire region; development and implementation of a standardized outdoor warning siren protocol; mapping levee changes in Holt County after the 2011 floods; Hazardous material location indentification in the region; Acquisition of new aerial photography showing land use change in the flood zone of Atchison and Holt Counties; Performing FEMA-mandated Substantial Damage Estimations on all structure affected by flooding in 2011 Holt County; Assisting the Missouri Spatial Data Inventory Service in the creation of a region wide database of all structures; indentifying interconnection and location of municipal water sources in the region; provide floodplain management assistance to Holt County; Assist Gentry County in the Risk Map process and joining the NFIP.

>Phelps County DI-65: Planning: Bridge survey visits and traffic counts completed for all counties in the region. Staff are currently completing the bridge survey reports for each county. Siren maps and final report have been completed for all eight counties. Due to on-going issues with the HAZUS software, staff is instead compiling a report of the data collected through the process to present to each county. The community resiliency strategy has been completed and added to the CEDS document. Staff will be presenting the information and final reports developed through the program to the MRPC board and county commissioners in the next quarter. Other Professional Services: No activities to report.

>Platte County DI-66: The grant is supporting work in three counties &ndash Cass, Platte and Ray. The grantsupported work has been completed as reported in previous quarters and the Administrator is working with the County to prepare files for closeout.

>Scotland County DI-67: Received removal of Environmental Conditions January 10, 2012. Project entails forward thinking land use planning that guides long-term recovery and subsequent land use decisions in disaster-eligible counties. Established mapping components and planning priorities. Six county floodplain maps and six count structures and Infrastructures maps have been prepared, reviewed and revised. Narrative draft has been prepared and is being reviewed. One Year extension granted first quarter 2013. Draft planning document narrative has been prepared. Insertion of ARC View mapping to follow in April 2014.

>Stoddard County DI-68: Staff assisted the Villge of Pinhook with the Flood Buyout Program; Staff assisting the City of Morehouse, City of Bertrand, City of Hornersville, Mississippi County, and Pemiscot County with their CDBG Flood Recovery Grants; created HAZUS stream flood data for all six counties; staff completed goals and objectives for land use plan; completed city/county GIS based flood maps; completed research of current land use for the region; and participated in a Community Assessment visit with the City of Oran and SEMA to help the City to try to obtain compliance with the National Flood Insurance Program; staff mailed Land-Use Policy Guide CD&rsquos to all cities for their record.

>Warren County DI-69: Preliminary mapping and infrastructure inventory is approximately 95% complete. Plan documents are 85% complete. Completion date has been extended to 12-31-14.

>Marble Hill DI-70: Project is completed and closed out.

>La Grange DI-71: The project was successfully closed out on March 15, 2013.

>Hannibal DI-72: There were no additional properties acquired or demolished during this reporting period. The project is completed. During this time period the close out paperwork has been completed, but not mailed, as I am waiting on the final RFF to be completed before sending the paperwork in. The final \$4,600 in administrative costs will be on the final RFF. The paperwork to de-obligate \$28,007.61 has also been filled out and submitted. Once the final RFF is received I will mail it in along with the close out paperwork.

>Jefferson City DI-73: Demolition of 601 (commercial), 605 (12 unit Apartment), 609 (12 Unit Apartment) and 711 (single family residential) Mulberry are 100% complete. A Deed of Trust was recorded on February 28, 2014, restricting the properties to green space following FEMA Regulations. Public Hearing was held on March 27,2014 at 3 pm within City Hall, to discuss accomplishments of the project. The public hearing notice was published in the News Tribune on March 17, 2014; was posted on the City&rsquos website; and City Clerk posted within City



Hall. Final RFF has been submitted on or around 3/12/14; finalization of documentation for in-kind staff time and cash match of demolition expenses will be completed by next quarter. Staff time will include program delivery and demolition inspections. All activities are 100% complete.

>Ferguson DI-74: The City continues to work with the property owners of 430 Suburban Avenue, to sign their sales contracts and close on the properties. The City continued to work with James Robnett of the Missouri Department of Economic Development, to review the flood repair expenditure history of 2 Burdale Ct and determine the difference between the duplication of benefits (DOB) and total expenditures. The City and CDBG are required to review this material, for compliance with the (DOB) regulations. The City has closed one more property, which includes: 2 Burdale Ct. Staff met with James Robnett of the Missouri Department of Economic Development, to conduct site visits on the properties purchased in the buyout program. TA contracting razed 13 homes, which include:

>Poplar Bluff DI-75: Project is complete. Closeout paperwork is being prepared.

>University City DI-76: Acquisition is 100% complete. Three closeout monitoring findings need to be resolved and the closeout packet paper work needs to be completed and submitted to DED. All acquisitions and demolitions were completed in 2011 and 2012. Were it not for issues with soliciting 100% participation from all original applicants and staff resource issues, the project would already be closed. The original project entailed the acquisition and demolition of 26 homes in University City. Three opted out as we experienced challenges with acquiring them due to foreclosure and house fire.

>Pettis County DI-77: Required documentation on Section 504 and Fair Housing was submitted to DED. Close out report submitted to DED on December 15, 2013. Accomplishments and final project closeout will occur in early April. >St. Louis DI-78: The City submitted an official proposal to the Department of Economic Development on December 11, 2013 in which we requested that the funding for Tornado Relief be reallocated in order to make infrastructure repairs to Lewis Place to include the installation of street lighting, sidewalk repairs, street repaving and other repairs. The request was formally approved by the Department of Economic Development on December 31, 2013. The City is currently working on submitting an Environmental Review to the Missouri Department of Economic Development prior to the commencement of any of the recently approved activities. Once the Environmental Review has been completed, activities will commence and progress will be reported on in subsequent reports. >HSTCC DI-79: The HSTCC staff continued the scope of work for the FY2012-13 EDA Planning Partnership Grant that will be matched with the remaining funds from this project. Some activities include: Staff provided technical assistance for a possible CDBG infrastructure project in Webb City, completed two Comprehensive Plans (Village of Saginaw & City of Carterville), attended IEDC training for Economic Development, met with area Chamber of Commerce to discuss programs and provide technical assistance, assisted the City of Carl Junction in completing a community survey for a new fiber optic network to be funded by USDA, attended an MEDC Finance Workshop in Jefferson City, provided technical assistance to MO-DNR for watershed project scoping. The remaining grant funds will be drawn down next quarter and closed out.

>Economic Security Corporation DI-80: Completed 14 rehab projects first quarter of 2012 and 11 houses in second quarter of 2012. Project completed and is awaiting closeout.

>Joplin DI-81: Project cancelled.

>Neighborhood Life House DI-82: NLH and the City of Joplin procured for work necessary to move the playground equipment to the three existing neighborhood parks. The HSTCC staff received final approval and the release of funds for the environmental review for the three parks.

>Duquesne 2008-DI-83: Rehabilitation of residential structures. Some progress was made on the rehabilitation of the home located at 1106 S. Duuesne Road however the weather conditions prohibited the replacement of windows and other work involved since it was too cold. There were no other applications for housing rehab during this



period. Reconstruction of residential structures: The homes at 4542 E 26th and 4460 E. 25th are 100% complete. The homes at 4971 E 27th is over 60% complete. There are three more project located at 4511 E. 26th, 4471 E 24th and 4561 E 25th that have cleared tier 2 Environmental reviews and were in the process of working on plans and specs for their homes. Three more applications were accepted during the period. One of them did not qualify due to being over income. Once family was unable to qualify for a loan to complete the construction of their home. The third application was still being reviewed by the end of the period to determine if they would qualify. There has only been one project that has included demolition to date (4460 E 25th), which included the removal of an old foundation and in-ground pool. None were during this quarter. The city is providing inspection services for all demo, rehab, and reconstruction work through their routine building department requirements including all work completed during this period. The HSTCC has provided all administrative services for the work for the period.

>Joplin Area Habitat for Humanity 2008-DI-84: The wage restitution for three of Habitat&rsquos own employees still remains. Habitat also plans to complete minor improvements (such as needed re-work on a couple of yards due to erosion). They are in the process of determining those final needs and plan to close-out the project as soon as they are completed and reimbursed by the grant.

>St. Louis County 2008-DI-85: Streetscape: 0% complete. The funds in this category will largely be spend on construction activities. This project is nearing the end of the design pahse. Next we will begin negotiating with property owners to purchase temporary easements and a small amount of right of way. Then we will finish design, complete the construction documents and go to bid. Then the construction phase will begin. Engineering design: 51% complete. The design work for the project is progressing into the construction document phase. Other Professional Services: 31% complete. The traffic study and civil survey of the project area have been completed. Other anticipated project asks in this category are anticipated to be completed during the construction phase of the project. The ene3x phase of our project is to begin acquiring temporary easements and some right of way from property owners.

>Full Employment Council 2008-DI-86: During the 3rd quarter many of the school aged youth had returned to school. Program providers stated that youth that participated in SPYC did a wonderful job. We had a total of 63 participants in the CDBG SPYC program. Some of the WIBs had problems filling their slots and the one WIB with 19 slots was only able to fill 6 slots. The issue was finding eligible youth that wanted to work in some of the more rural areas. Some of the participants were able to gain experience in their degree and future careers and some even go the opportunity to participate in a movie that was filmed at the Nathan Boone Homestead. The SPYC program allowed participants to work as a team and follow oral and written instructions while gaining work experience. The participants seem to accept roles and responsibilities while adhering to the policies and procedures that had been outline to them.

>Greene County - SBDC 2008-DI-87: 15 job training participants to date; Two (2) business partners agreements are in effect.

>Jefferson City Chamber 2008-DI-88: Marketing for the program continues this quarter and fourteen (14) business partners have been identified to date.

Innovate St. Louis 2008-DI-89: Marketing for the program is continuing. No applications have been received yet.
 Seven (7) business partner agreements are in effect.
