#### **Narratives**

#### **Disaster Damage:**

**DREF** - Anticipated Unmet Needs

The State of Missouri received more than 230 applications for funding in excess of \$250,000,000 for our PL-110-329 appropriation. This is nearly two and one half times the state's awarded grant amount. To date we have awarded 55,230,947 that are detailed in DRGR, with another \$25,071,500 committed and in process of executed grants. There are applications currently in our review and development process that will exceed the remaining Supplemental Appropriation and will be awarded based on competitive scoring.

Missouri is proposing to dedicate \$5M of funding to access a dollar for dollar match of \$5M more in DREF funds. The funds will be offered using a request for proposals or notice of fund availability method of distribution. Applicants will be evaluated on need, impact, and local effort. The State of Missouri has a significant amount of land mass residing in the 100 year and 500 year floodplain, as defined by the Federal Emergency Management Agency FIRM maps. Historically, the state developed using the river network (Missouri River and Mississippi River and their tributaries) as a transportation network to ship goods to the west. As such, communities developed and grew along those rivers and tributaries. That growth has contributed to flooding events that impact the health, safety and well-being of Missourian&rsquos. Loss of life and loss of homes, businesses, personal property and the devastation to real property has burdened the state during significant, widespread flooding events. Between 1990 and 2009, Missouri recorded more than 90 deaths due to flash and riverine flooding. Proof of that widespread damaging capacity came in the form of a Presidential disaster declaration for 106 of the 114 total counties in the State in 2008. Missouri is home to 977 cities, towns and villages in those 114 counties.

Since the floods of 1993, Missouri has created and implemented an aggressive buyout of properties in the floodplain and we have realized substantial savings as a result. More than 1000 properties have been purchased and deed restricted in perpetuity to open space activities in the last decade and one half. Those properties will never again receive a National Flood Insurance Program payment. They will never subject a resident to danger or experience damage to a structure. The program can be called a success. However, FEMA estimates that more than 216,000 households are within designated floodplains in Missouri. To date, in the short period between the notice of available DREF funding, wehave identified 5 more communities that are prepared to support more buyout activities. There are more eligible properties, more willing communities, and more families deserving of a decent, safe and sanitary comparable home, outside of the floodplain. Many of these communities will use CDBG funds to match FEMA Hazard Mitigation funding but there are additional, smaller river communities that are not eligible for FEMA funds, that our efforts could support, as well.

Even with the buyout activities, Missouri&rsquos communities will always be linked to the rivers. Their future, their viability and in many cases their economic activity is still linked to the waterways. It is for that reason, that access to fundingland use planning for many Missouri communities is vial. Currently, thereis no state resource available in Missouri for planning activities. We have regional planning commissions, councils of government, and federally designated economic development districts. Those service providers assist with economic development strategic planning, redevelopment planning and planning related to specific projects. There is however, a gap in a community&rsquos access to real land use planning.

Some mitigation efforts in Missouri have been driven by need as a response to an event. Land use planning will give many communities an opportunity to address that next step of development or redevelopment through a systematic analysis of land assets that derives efficient uses of land. A forward thinking land use plan will include views of the many facets of land use and the many impacts including the environment, society, and the local economy.

#### Areas of Greatest Need

>The Consolidated Security, Disaster Assistance, and Continuing Appropriations Act (PL-110-329 and hereafter identified as the Second 2008 Act) appropriates over \$6 billion in CDBG funds for necessary expenses related to disaster relief, long-term recovery, and restoration of infrastructure, housing and economic revitalization in areas affected by hurricanes, flooding and other natural disasters that occurred during 2008. The allocation awarded to Missouri from this Supplemental Appropriation is \$92,605,490. There were six separate Presidentially-declared Disasters in Missouri during 2008. At least 3,892 homes were affected by weather related events in 2008, with 1,839 being affected, 1,488 sustaining minor damage, 320 sustaining major damage, and 245 being destroyed. At least 22 levees were affected by the flood; total estimated repair cost is \$36,139,000. U.S. Army Corps of Engineers funding will address the bulk of this; CDBG funding from the regular state program and from the First Supplemental Disaster Appropriation have assisted several communities in providing match for Corps funding. A portion of these levees are being addressed with existing CDBG funds, but total assistance needed by local governments and levee districts greatly exceeds existing funding.

At least two communities in northeast Missouri have reported businesses affected to the extent that buyout and relocation of these businesses is desired. Widespread damage to public infrastructure has been reported by communities and regional planning commissions.

The federal disaster declarations that are relevant to this supplemental appropriation are 1742, 1748, 1749, 1760, 1773, and 1809, and areas eligible for assistance are indicated on the FEMA website for the six declared disasters. All counties marked as designated during any 2008 disaster, as well as the cities within those designated counties, are eligible to apply for these supplemental funds. Areas not eligible for this funding include Benton, Caldwell, Clay, Clinton, DeKalb, Henry, Jackson and Lafayette counties.

Projects related to disaster relief, long-term recovery and restoration of infrastructure, housing and economic revitalization in areas affected by the declared disasters are prioritized as the areas of Greatest Need.

>These supplemental disaster CDBG funds may not be used for activities reimbursable by or for which funds are made available by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) or the Army Corps of Engineers. Further, none of these supplemental disaster CDBG funds may be used as the required match, share, or contribution for another federal program. The supplemental appropriation will have no specific set-asides for individual application categories. All applications will be evaluated on the criteria listed in the Application Evaluation section of the HUD-approved Action Plan. The total supplemental appropriationis\$92,605,490.Nolessthan\$10,372,631mustbeused foraffordablerental housing. The maximum amount that will be used for administration (both state and local) is \$4,630,274. Projects related to disaster relief, long-term recovery and restoration of infrastructure, housing and economic revitalization in areas affected by presidentially declared disasters in 2008 are eligible for this funding. Proposed water or wastewater projects must still participate in the Missouri Water and Wastewater Review Committee process unless the proposed project is limited to direct disaster recovery.

Project Dates and Duration of Assistance, Locations/Responsible Organizations

>Projects being undertaken as part of this supplemental appropriation will follow the same guidelines for project period as the state&rsquos regular non-entitlement CDBG allocation. All Grantees are local governments that will have 24 months from the time of award to expend and close-out the project.

Amendment #2 to second Disaster Supplemental Action Plan

On December 31st, 2010 a tornado struck Lambert Airport in St. Louis and the surrounding neighborhoods and businesses in St. Louis City and County causing significant damage to homes and businesses in the area.

On May 22, 2011 an EF-5, multi-vortex tornado struck the heart of Joplin, Duquene and parts of Jasper and Newton Counties, leaving a six mile long and one mile wide path of destruction to homes, businesses, and infrastructure forever changing the fabric of this community and region. The tornado caused a tragic loss of life with current related deaths at 155, which is higher than any death toll from a tornado in 50 years. There are a large number of individuals still hospitalized from the tornado, many fighting to survive.

On May 25th, 2011 a tornado struck Pettis County causing damage to a mobile home park, businesses and school property. Each of these tornados has caused damage to the housing and the economic infrastructure of the communities. Although the current impacts are not directly related to the damage suffered in 2008, each has unmet needs from 2008. Through this amendment, these communities may access CDBG, under the eligible categories and eligible activities listed in this Plan, to address these current and unmet needs.

Amendment #2 to second Disaster Supplemental Action Plan

Unmet Need from 2008

>Already reeling from multiple weather related events in 2008, the region had suffered previous loss of homes and businesses through tornados and flooding from which they had not recovered. Multiple Presidential disaster declarations were made as a result of the repeated damaging weather in 2008. In addition, 2010-2011 Tornado events have exacerbated needs in some areas. The state is proposing to allocate \$27,000,000 to allow communities affected by tornadoes in 2010 and 2011 to access 2008 Disaster Supplemental funds to address housing and economic revitalization needs that were exacerbated by the 2010/2011 events, or otherwise meet unmet needs from 2008. While specific detailed grantee activities are still being determined, housing and business lending and demolition activities are expected to comprise all of the reserved amount. Initial estimate of business lending is being allocated at \$3,000,000. The \$3,000,000 is set up as a project in the action plan, and the remaining \$24,000,000 is set up as a project until specific housing and other activities are identified.

## **Overall Progress Narrative:**

Many projects are still undergoing the environmental review process necessary to release funding. Other projects in varying stages of progress are listed below.

New Madrid County DI-02: Project complete and has been closed out.

- >St. Louis County DI-03:
- >Dixon DI-04: Project is undergoing environmental review process.
- >Eminence DI-05: Environmental assessment is complete and release of funds issued. Easements are being acquired and administrator is being solicited.
- >Macon County DI-06: Project is being review to determine feasibility since original bids far exceeded funds available.
- >Maryville DI-07: Project is complete. Closeout public hearing scheduled for July 25, 2011.
- >Morgan County DI-09: Environmental review is under review. FONSI published July 14. Design is complete and bidding will begin the middle of August.
- >Nodaway County DI-10: Two bridges complete and third bridge will be constructed.
- >Pulaski County DI-11: Project is currently undergoing engineering design.
- >Schuyler County DI-13: Environmental Review complete. Bridge material bids and debar checks completed. Contracts for material are being prepared.
- >Scotland County DI-14: Environmental Review completed. Bridge material specs prepared and bid call set for July.
- >Jefferson City DI-15: Combined notice has been published and will request release of funds and certification.
- >St. Louis County DI-16: Project continuing the Environmental Review process. Have issued RFP for child care operator services. Held pre-proposal conference June 28.

The goal is to have every student in the nursing program filter through the Simulation Lab during the semester for feedback on process.
- >Cass County &ndash DI-20: Completed delivery of pilot sessions for the following courses: Vet Front Office and Support Staff course online and in veterinary clinics (13 participants); Health Unit Coordinator course online and at MCC Health Science Institute (17 participants, so far, 3 have sat for the HUC credentialing exam and all have passed); Incident Response for Health Care Facilities course (5 participants); Emergency Evacuation & Disaster

Preparedness course (21 participants).

- >Franklin County &ndash DI-21: Courses in Introduction to ERP and Supply Chain Management have been developed and are currently being taught to students at both the Union and Rolla campuses.
- >Greene County &ndash DI-22: Simulated Driver Training Program Expansion continued training on the PES (personnel evaluation system) on the DORON simulator, by DORON trainers, for two instructors was completed; students served 20. Health Care Certification Program Expansion included a Certified Nurse Assistant beta class that began on June 6 and continues at this time; students served 24.
- >Grundy County &ndash DI-23: Staff continued with development of curriculum in agriculture, natural resources and alternative fuels and alternative energy for revised, expanded and new courses to be taught at NCMC. Most of these revised, expanded and new class will be taught at NCMC&rsquos Barton Farm Campus under construction. >Jefferson County &ndash DI-24: To date have not expended funds.
- >Newton County &ndash DI-25: The Spring 2011 Phlebotomy course were offered to Twenty-four students that completed the program and twenty-one passed the National Phlebotomy Certification. Training of instructors for the use of the Transport Training Simulators has now been fully completed and all instructors are now capable of operating the simulators. Since the beginning of April 2011, 31 student drivers and 10 experienced drivers have utilized training with the simulators, bringing the total since inception to 92 student drivers and 16 experienced drivers.
- >Pettis County &ndash DI-26: Continued working with our Curriculum Designer to develop our curriculum for the Renewable Energy programs &ndash Solar Panel Installer, Bio Mass Technician and Energy Systems Technician. The Renewable Energy degree program was submitted to the Coordinating Board for Higher Education and was approved at the February board meeting of the Missouri Department of Higher Education.
- >Randolph County &ndash DI-27: Order simulation equipment and clinical lab supplies and instructional materials. MACC has conducted 4 CNA classes through 5/25/2011 (we will have completed two classes during this quarter) with a class presently ongoing. A total of 32 individuals have begun the class since October, 2010. Of those 32 individuals, 17 employees have tested and 17 have passed.
- >St. Charles County &ndash DI-28: To date have not expended funds.
- >St. Francois County &ndash DI-29: Began utilizing Sim-lab with nursing and paramedic classes.
- >St. Louis City &ndash DI-30: To date have not expended funds.
- >Belton DI-32: Construction progress continues. 34 Certificates of Occupancy have been issued. 17 homes are currently occupied and 19 applications are pending. All homes are completely framed, roofed and bricked and scheduled to be turned over to management by the end of the week. Energy Star has passed all units tested to date. >Moberly DI-33: Concrete and sidewalk replacement is complete. All site work is complete around the apartment buildings. City has issued Certificates of Occupancy for all units and Architect has issued a certificate of substantial completion.
- >St. Martin&rsquos DI-41: Orders placed for ADA compliant windows and showers and installed in 17 units. Project completion estimated in 3-4 weeks.

Furnished base and flood maps to the National Guards for deployment planning for safety and security assistance to the local law enforcement in the six counties of Dunklin, Mississippi, New Madrid, Pemiscot, Scott and Stoddard.
- >Jefferson CityDI-73: Working on Environmental Review for clearance in the floodplain.
- >Poplar Bluff DI-75: Administration contracts are executed. RFP for appraisal and title work has started and Environmental review has commenced.
- >University City DI-76: Environmental Review record was submitted for the project and city is awaiting the issuance of the &ldquonotice of removal of grant conditions&rdquo.
