Disaster Damage:

DREF - Anticipated Unmet Needs

The State of Missouri received more than 230 applications for funding in excess of \$250,000,000 for our PL-110-329 appropriation. This is nearly two and one half times the state's awarded grant amount. To date we have awarded 55,230,947 that are detailed in DRGR, with another \$25,071,500 committed and in process of executed grants. There are applications currently in our review and development process that will exceed the remaining Supplemental Appropriation and will be awarded based on competitive scoring.

Missouri is proposing to dedicate \$5M of funding to access a dollar for dollar match of \$5M more in DREF funds. The funds will be offered using a request for proposals or notice of fund availability method of distribution. Applicants will be evaluated on need, impact, and local effort. The State of Missouri has a significant amount of land mass residing in the 100 year and 500 year floodplain, as defined by the Federal Emergency Management Agency FIRM maps. Historically, the state developed using the river network (Missouri River and Mississippi River and their tributaries) as a transportation network to ship goods to the west. As such, communities developed and grew along those rivers and tributaries. That growth has contributed to flooding events that impact the health, safety and well-being of Missourian&rsquos. Loss of life and loss of homes, businesses, personal property and the devastation to real property has burdened the state during significant, widespread flooding events. Between 1990 and 2009, Missouri recorded more than 90 deaths due to flash and riverine flooding. Proof of that widespread damaging capacity came in the form of a Presidential disaster declaration for 106 of the 114 total counties in the State in 2008. Missouri is home to 977 cities, towns and villages in those 114 counties.

Since the floods of 1993, Missouri has created and implemented an aggressive buyout of properties in the floodplain and we have realized substantial savings as a result. More than 1000 properties have been purchased and deed restricted in perpetuity to open space activities in the last decade and one half. Those properties will never again receive a National Flood Insurance Program payment. They will never subject a resident to danger or experience damage to a structure. The program can be called a success. However, FEMA estimates that more than 216,000 households are within designated floodplains in Missouri. To date, in the short period between the notice of available DREF funding, we have identified 5 more communities that are prepared to support more buyout activities. There are more eligible properties, more willing communities, and more families deserving of a decent, safe and sanitary comparable home, outside of the floodplain. Many of these communities will use CDBG funds to match FEMA Hazard Mitigation funding but there are additional, smaller river communities that are not eligible for FEMA funds, that our efforts could support, as well.

Even with the buyout activities, Missouri&rsquos communities will always be linked to the rivers. Their future, their viability and in many cases their economic activity is still linked to the waterways. It is for that reason, that access to fundingland use plCurrently, thereis no state resource available in Missouri for planning activities. We have regional planning commissions, councils of government, and federally designated economic development districts. Those service providers assist with economic development strategic planning, redevelopment planning and planning related to specific projects. There is however, a gap in a community&rsquos access to real land use planning. Some mitigation efforts in Missouri have been driven by need as a response to an event. Land use planning will give many communities an opportunity to address that next step of development or redevelopment through a systematic analysis of land assets that derives efficient uses of land. A forward thinking land use plan will include views of the many facets of land use and the many impacts including the environment, society, and the local economy.



Areas of Greatest Need

>The Consolidated Security, Disaster Assistance, and Continuing Appropriations Act (PL-110-329 and hereafter identified as the Second 2008 Act) appropriates over \$6 billion in CDBG funds for necessary expenses related to disaster relief, long-term recovery, and restoration of infrastructure, housing and economic revitalization in areas affected by hurricanes, flooding and other natural disasters that occurred during 2008. The allocation awarded to Missouri from this Supplemental Appropriation is \$92,605,490. There were six separate Presidentially-declared Disasters in Missouri during 2008. At least 3,892 homes were affected by weather related events in 2008, with 1,839 being affected, 1,488 sustaining minor damage, 320 sustaining major damage, and 245 being destroyed. At least 22 levees were affected by the flood; total estimated repair cost is \$36,139,000. U.S. Army Corps of Engineers funding will address the bulk of this; CDBG funding from the regular state program and from the First Supplemental Disaster Appropriation have assisted several communities in providing match for Corps funding. A portion of these levees are being addressed with existing CDBG funds, but total assistance needed by local governments and levee districts greatly exceeds existing funding.

At least two communities in northeast Missouri have reported businesses affected to the extent that buyout and relocation of these businesses is desired. Widespread damage to public infrastructure has been reported by communities and regional planning commissions.

The federal disaster declarations that are relevant to this supplemental appropriation are 1742, 1748, 1749, 1760, 1773, and 1809, and areas eligible for assistance are indicated on the FEMA website for the six declared disasters. All counties marked as designated during any 2008 disaster, as well as the cities within those designated counties, are eligible to apply for these supplemental funds. Areas not eligible for this funding include Benton, Caldwell, Clay, Clinton, DeKalb, Henry, Jackson and Lafayette counties.

Projects related to disaster relief, long-term recovery and restoration of infrastructure, housing and economic revitalization in areas affected by the declared disasters are prioritized as the areas of Greatest Need.

>These supplemental disaster CDBG funds may not be used for activities reimbursable by or for which funds are made available by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) or the Army Corps of Engineers. Further, none of these supplemental disaster CDBG funds may be used as the required match, share, or contribution for another federal program. The supplemental appropriation will have no specific set-asides for individual application categories. All applications will be evaluated on the criteria listed in the Application Evaluation section of the HUD-approved Action Plan. The total supplemental appropriationis\$92,605,490.Nolessthan\$10,372,631mustbeused foraffordablerental housing. The maximumamount that will be used for administration (both state and local) is \$4,630,274. Projects related to disaster relief, long-term recovery and restoration of infrastructure, housing and economic revitalization in areas affected by presidentially declared disasters in 2008 are eligible for this funding. Proposed water or wastewater projects must still participate in the Missouri Water and Wastewater Review Committee process unless the proposed project is limited to direct disaster recovery.

Project Dates and Duration of Assistance, Locations/Responsible Organizations

>Projects being undertaken as part of this supplemental appropriation will follow the same guidelines for project period as the state&rsquos regular non-entitlement CDBG allocation. All Grantees are local governments that will have 24 months from the time of award to expend and close-out the project.

Amendment #2 to second Disaster Supplemental Action Plan

On December 31st, 2010 a tornado struck Lambert Airport in St. Louis and the surrounding neighborhoods and businesses in St. Louis City and County causing significant damage to homes and businesses in the area.

On May 22, 2011 an EF-5, multi-vortex tornado struck the heart of Joplin, Duquene and parts of Jasper and Newton Counties, leaving a six mile long and one mile wide path of destruction to homes, businesses, and infrastructure forever changing the fabric of this community and region. The tornado caused a tragic loss of life with current related deaths at 155, which is higher than any death toll from a tornado in 50 years. There are a large number of individuals still hospitalized from the tornado, many fighting to survive.

On May 25th, 2011 a tornado struck Pettis County causing damage to a mobile home park, businesses and school property.

Each of these tornados has caused damage to the housing and the economic infrastructure of the communities. Although the current impacts are not directly related to the damage suffered in 2008, each has unmet needs from 2008. Through this amendment, these communities may access CDBG, under the eligible categories and eligible activities listed in this Plan, to address these current and unmet needs.

Amendment #2 to second Disaster Supplemental Action Plan

Unmet Need from 2008

>Already reeling from multiple weather related events in 2008, the region had suffered previous loss of homes and businesses through tornados and flooding from which they had not recovered. Multiple Presidential disaster declarations were made as a result of the repeated damaging weather in 2008. In addition, 2010-2011 Tornado events have exacerbated needs in some areas. The state is proposing to allocate \$27,000,000 to allow communities affected by tornadoes in 2010 and 2011 to access 2008 Disaster Supplemental funds to address housing and economic revitalization needs that were exacerbated by the 2010/2011 events, or otherwise meet unmet needs from 2008. While specific detailed grantee activities are still being determined, housing and business lending and demolition activities are expected to comprise all of the reserved amount. Initial estimate of business lending is being allocated at \$3,000,000. The \$3,000,000 is set up as a project in the action plan, and the remaining \$24,000,000 is set up as a project until specficic housing and other activities are identified. 2008 Disaster Declarations in Missouri:

Overall Progress Narrative:

Mexico DI-01: During the quarter, SoyLabs continued to adapt the processing plant to meet current requirements and market at various venues.

- >New Madrid County DI-02: Project complete and has been closed out.
- >St. Louis County DI-03: Continue to implement Aerostrata&rsquos recommendations to aggressively reach out to freight forwarders to secure export backhaul commitments and communicate air cargo opportunities to carriers around the globe.
- >Dixon DI-04: The City is in process of procuring materials needed for this project.
- >Eminence DI-05: Construction of water lines began on August 6. The first payrolls have been reviewed and processed and employee interviews have been completed.
- >Macon County DI-06: Project was re-bid to determine feasibility since original bids far exceeded funds available. Pre-construction conference and contract signing scheduled for October 1. Funds for engineering only have been drawn to date.
- >Maryville DI-07: Closed
- >Montgomery County DI-08: The project will result in construction of a bridge over Hwy 19 over the railroad tracks south of Montgomery City. The Missouri Department of Transportation is currently working on budgeting funds to match the CDBG disaster funds.
- >Morgan County DI-09: Project is completed and closed out.
- >Nodaway County DI-10: The remaining funds for bridge #686 will be used toward bridge #403, which is now 50% complete.
- >Pulaski County DI-11: Project is currently in the engineering design phase. MRPC staff is also working on environmental review.
- >Savannah DI-12: Second construction bids came in over engineers estimate and were rejected. City is in the process of reviewing project and making changes to bring bids in closer to budget. The third bid opening is scheduled for October 10.



- >Schuvler County DI-13: Project was funded to address three small bridges, 3 bridges are complete and a fourth bridge will begin construction next quarter, weather permitting. Construction on the other three bridges is scheduled for Spring.
- >Scotland County DI-14: The project was funded to address county bridges #159 and #387. Engineering plans/specs are still being prepared for review by MODOT.
- >Jefferson City DI-15: Six buildings were demolished. Asbestos air monitoring and engineering design were also underway this quarter.
- >St. Louis County DI-16: Construction of the childcare center was documented 90% complete at September 6. >Taney County DI-17: Project is 95% complete. Billing for a large amount of construction cost will be received in October and will include balance of CDBG funds and county match.
- >St. Genevieve County DI-18: The loadout facility port project is under contract. Construction began September 8. As of 9/30, the project is 24% complete.
- >Butler County DI-19: The draw downs for this quarter were to reimburse for the last two quarter&rsquos purchases. The students served beginning August 2012, are by a college paid faculty member. No students served this quarter. Last reporting period.
- >Cass County DI-20: Completed delivery of pilot sessions of 2 additional Medical Interpreter courses, Teenage Patients and Legal Issues and Language Access. 18 and 21 participants respectively. 1 additional advanced topic course is in development for pilot in Oct 2012. Completed delivery of pilot sessions of the Animal Care Technician course to 8 participants. Began or continued development of 6 more program to be offered as college curriculum. Franklin County &ndash DI-21: Health Information Management is preparing to make necessary changes for July&rsquos accreditation workshop. Background check process was completed. Chemical Technology curriculum has been developed for two courses (Analytical Chemistry and Chem Tech II). Licensed Practical Nurse to RN Bridge second semester curriculum was updated to a Web hybrid format. Two Culinary Arts students are expected to graduate this summer (2012).
- >Greene County &ndash DI-22: Health Care Certification Program Extension &ndash Twelve (12) students served with addition of &Isquomodular driving&rsquo instructor; 6 Students in the Dental Assisting Program pilot Hybrid Track have completed six of the twelve-month block of courses. Manufacturing Technology Program Expansion served 30 students. Hearing Instrument Specialist Program served 5 students. 338 students were served in the Nursing Program expansion. Training continues to grow as demand for equipment increases.
- >Grundy County &ndash DI-23: Funds were spent to purchase equipment for revised courses in agriculture, natural resources, alternative fuels and life sciences fields at the Barton Farm Campus. On this campus Three classrooms and laboratory buildings were built and all were open for the Fall 2012 Semester.
- >A full-time agriculture/natural resources instructor was hired, starting on TFT grant funds.
- >Jefferson County &ndash DI-24: Occupational Therapy Assistant: Much of the work for this quarter has been on self study for ACOTE accreditation which was submitted in August of this year. The second cohort class will begin January 2013. Respiratory Therapist: All developed curriculum for this program has been approved. 6 students have been accepted into the first class. Physical Therapy Asst.: The accrediting site visit happened this quarter and candidacy status is expected in November. 21 students are taking PTA 100 and 12 students are enrolled in PTA 105 this quarter. Radiological Technician: Continuing conversation with St. Charles CC to develop a similar Rad Tech Program at that institution. Accreditation has been approved this quarter. - St. Louis City &ndash DI-30: Four courses were completed for the Aerospace Program at the beginning of this



quarter. The Network Engineering Program was completed with 38 students completing the Beta classes. Equipment purchases for this program are complete. A number of students are enrolled for the Fall Semester: Hybrid and Electric Vehicle Maintenance-79 students, Sustainable Environmental Design- 27 students, Sustainable Energy Technology- 5 students, Sustainable Construction Technology- 57 students, Life Sciences Pathway- 16 students, Biomedical Engineering Technical Certificate- 11 students. The commitment of two cohort classes for this grant has been successfully met with Patient Care Technician Certificate (8 of the 9 completed students with job placement) and Medical Information Intake Specialist Program.

Perryville DI-31: Project completed and closed out. 329 confirmed jobs.

- >Belton DI-32: Have received all 36 Certificates of Occupancy and all 36 homes are leased. Project completed and closed out.
- >Moberly DI-33: Project completed and closed out.
- >Harrisonville DI-34: Project closed. There are a total of 42 units; for a total of 40 Low-income; 2 moderate income and 21 Female Head of Household. There are a total of 38 white households, 3 black/African American households, and 1 American Indian/Alaskan Native & White household.
- >Eldon DI-36: Project is complete and has been closed out.
- >Crawford County DI-37: Rehabilitation of 20 of the projected 40 unit is approximately complete.
- >St. Louis DI-38: The entire project is approximately 92% complete. Sixteen units have been released from construction for occupancy. None of the units are occupied at this time. No direct benefit data is available at this time.
- >Brashear DI-39: 8 apartments and 4 duplex units were substantially completed April 1, 2012. Four apartments have been rented and applications for the remaining units are being accepted.
- >St. Louis DI-40: Project involves the new construction of 6 building additions (11 units and management office/community space). Rehabilitation is underway on all 40 proposed units.
- >St. Martin&rsquos DI-41: Project closed.
- >Osage County DI-42: Environmental review is complete. Project will be ready to bid on or about October 15, pending comments from the state.
- >Pulaski County DI-43: Properties have been selected. All inspections have been completed. Environmental Assessment is complete and being reviewed by state staff.
- >St. Louis County DI-44:
- >Bellefontaine Neighbors DI-45: Drawings are complete, working on specifications. Overall project engineering bid design is 90% complete. 21 buildings are proposed and will be bid for demolition in January.
- >Houston DI-46: Construction on the sewer contract has begun. Construction on the streets will commence next quarter.
- >Lake Ozark DI-47 &ndash The project is done. Awaiting information related to match funds from the Missouri Department of Transportation to close out projec.br />Cuba DI-48: Construction contracts have been awarded and work began in July. Contractor completion dates are 12/12/12 and 2/10/13.
- >Pettis County DI-49: An initial RFP for project was completed and sent out, but bids were noncompliant. The technical specs were re-written and the RFP was let for a second time. The engineer bid was also written, an engineer selected and expended funds on design. Retained counsel to assist in negotiating and documenting the revenue side of the project, which is electrical interconnection to the grid and power sales.
- >Canton DI-50: All demolition is completed, and sites have been seeded and mulched per the project specifications. Nine properties, with a total of six buildings, were acquired from 3 owners.
- >Platte County DI-51: There has been a change since applying for the grant. Funds are pending.
- >Audrain DI-52: Implementing scope of work activities, including floodplain critical infrastructure mapping, locating/mapping emergency sirens, data collection for Mark Twain Lake inundation study.
- >Buchanan County DI-53: Researched related land use papers. Updated county officials and emergency management directors on project&rsquos progress. Participated in &ldquoContinuity of Government Operations Planning for Rural Communities&rdquo training in July, 2012. This eight-hour course is designed to help government officials and emergency responders from rural communities in the development of plans that will ensure the continuity of essential government functions across a spectrum of emergencies. Made an inventory of potential/historical disasters for Andrew and Buchanan counties, in order to complete risk assessment, and cost-benefit analysis. Evaluated need for GIS, Photoshop, etc. software. Toured levee districts along the Missouri River. Cooperated with Mark Duewell from University of Missouri MSDIS to create a map coding every residential and commercial structure in Andrew and Buchanan counties. These points will be given attributes that may help with land use planning. Reviewed existing Hazard Mitigation Plans for Andrew and Buchanan counties. Purchased the most recent aerial photography for Buchanan County. This aerial imagery was facilitated by Mid-America Regional Council. Continued to participate in Outdoor Warning Siren working group meetings monthly in July September. The group has completed the final draft document of standards for activation and testing of outdoor warning



sirens. We anticipate it being printed and disseminated in November. Continued compiling and digitizing storm siren data for Region H Outdoor Warning Siren working group. This project will ultimately result in storm siren maps showing individual siren locations and their approximate radii. This will be coupled with population centers, which will help decision-makers determine potential locations for future sirens. Attended SEMA training for &IdquoMitigation for Emergency Managers&rdquo in Jefferson City from September 25th to September 27th, 2012.Determined time, location, speakers and potential attendees for a StormReady workshop. Updated timeline and scope of work for CDBG Disaster Recovery project. Printed Equal Housing flyers. The flyers were distributed in senior centers, courthouse and county facilities in Andrew and Buchanan counties.

>Butler County DI-54: Low water crossings have been located and rated, photographed and recorded. Work ontnues on flood plain comparisons for Butler and Wayne counties.

>Callaway County DI-55: Mid-MO Regional Planning Commission staff continued to meet with the Village of Wooldridge on planning, buyout assistance for homeowners with property loss in the Missouri River floodplain. Discussion with elected officials and citizens centered on analysis of homeowners&rsquo options for buyout assistance or applications for demolition. RPC staff researched and prepared materials for business continuity and disaster recovery planning sessions. Manuals, policies were developed for educational training workshops. Maps were created for warning siren locations in the region.

>Cedar County DI-56: Actual plan is progressing well. Continuing work on mapping element and identify maps needed as well as different GIS layers that will be required for completion. Mapping of storm siren locations in Cedar County in process, using new camera that list GIS location of sirens on photos and allows mapping with those coordinates. Working on obtaining additional mapping resources and assistance with MU spatial data center as well as Great River Associates. Landscape Architect firm selected through formal RFQ process, for mapping and other related professional services.

>Greene County DI-57: Pictometry aerial photography for Greene and Christian Counties were completed. Landuse suitability analysis, low water crossing inventory and mapping and critical infrastructure inventory is ongoing. >Grundy County DI-58: Working to identify each Presidential Declaration for each county for the last ten years, as well as the those areas where damage was sufficient enough to require FEMA assistance to repair. These will be mapped and comparisons will be done.

>Howell County DI-59: FEMA&rsquos latest HAZUS floodplain management data was obtained and utilized to create unofficial floodplain maps for participating communities that do not have adequate (recent) NFIP maps. Plan narratives are being developed for each community with the current focus being on changes in demographic characteristics since the 2000 census and the intersection between identified future growth areas and high hazard areas. A region-wide storm siren mapping project has begun.

>Jasper County DI-60: Preliminary information was collected (including flood plain maps, etc.) for the project. A schedule of local meetings to begin the local input was put on hold in order to coordinate efforts with other RPCs close to our region.

>Johnson County DI-61: Finalized acquisition for the Pettis County terrain data and notebook purchase. Floodplain maps are updated.

>Laclede County DI-62: Several meetings this quarter with Camden County Planning & Zoning regarding local issues. List of EMDs and Floodplain Managers for the region was compiled. Next step will be to convene and identify priority training needs. Camden County&rsquos Floodplain Manager is in the process of becoming a Certified Floodplain Manager. Laclede County&rsquos mapping is completed.

>Nodaway County DI-63: This project is still on-going. NWMORCOG staff have been facilitating short-term flood recovery in Atchison and Holt counties for municipalities, as well as multiple levee, road, and drainage districts. This facilitation has included planning meetings with various boards and elected officials, project planning and management, resource identification and procuremen, nd multi-tier coordination between locally-impacted agencies and state/federal programs. With short term recovery well underway, NWMORCOG staff are now turning attention to region-wide projects, including disaster plan inventory and analysis, vulnerable population study, revised levee mapping, and overall threat assessment. In addition, staff are developing a proposal for a &ldquonext generation comprehensive river management study&rdquo, which will serve as a land management pilot for properties not currently protected by federal levees. In July and August the office work for the tornado siren project began. At this time the final report is being written. The levee project has been with staff traveling the levess of Holt County. >Perry County DI-64: Technical assistance and/or planning for land utilization in high hazard areas&mdashin progress. Localized mapping as it relates to communities and modified flood zones and decertified levees-5 out of 7 counties completed. Review, evaluation and confirmation of revised flood maps to ensure accuracy and reliability completed. Technical assistance for completing cost-benefit analysis for hazard mitigation funding progress in professional development training for local community leaders responsible for flood plain management in progress. Identification, mapping and mitigation planning for critical infrastructure in progress 50 % complete. Integration of program outcomes with various state and federal agencies&mdashTBD.



>Phelps County DI-65: Staff is nearing completion on gathering data on essential facilities for HAZUS. The next step will be to input the data into the HAZUS system. Bridge surveys and traffic counts are being completed. >Platte County DI-66: The grant is supporting work in three counties &ndash Cass, Platte and Ray. Progress was made toward the work activities and deliverables for each county&rsquos work plan during the third quarter of 2012. Ray County: The consultant, Shockey Consulting, prepared a report on the stakeholder interviews conducted in the fourth quarter of 2011. MARC staff and the consultant met with the Ray County Floodplain Management/Planning and Zoning Administrator on August 22 to discuss adoption of the draft plan and modifications to the county&rsquos existing floodplain management ordinance. MARC staff and the consultant then met with the Ray County Commissioners later that day to review the materials and determine their next steps in review and adoption of the plan and revised ordinance. MARC and the consultant finalized the plan, handout documents and other materials and delivered those materials to the county. Platte County: The project consultants, Applied Ecological Services (AES) and Vireo, completed their work and met with Platte County representatives to share the findings and final report for the evaluation of flood mitigation opportunities through natural resource protection and property acquisition. Cass County: The Cass County Sustainability Committee and South Grand River Watershed Association finalized an inventory of the properties identified as within flood hazard areas on the new FEMA NFIP maps. The two organizations drafted educational information to be presented to county officials and placed on the two organizations&rsquo websites to inform the public. MARC staff edited the educational information to assist the two organizations in finalizing the materials.MARC worked with the consultants invovd in supporting hazard mitigation planning work for the three counties, and assisted Platte County in work to meet fair housing, ADA and

>County DI-67: Established mapping components and planning priorities for DREF project. Six county floodplain maps and six county structures and infrastructure maps have been prepared.

other CDBG requirements. MARC worked with Platte County to plan a public meeting prior to the close-out of the

- >Stoddard County DI-68: Staff assisted the village of Pinhook with the Flood Buyout Program; created HAZUS stream flood data for all six counties; staff is developing goals and objectives for land use plan; developing city/county GIS based flood maps; and researching current land use for the region.
- >Warren County DI-69: Preliminary mapping and infrastructure inventory is 75% complete. Plan documents are 50% complete.
- >Marble Hill DI-70: Project is complete. 4 houses and properties were acquired by the City of Marble Hill and were demolished. The 5th house in the original project was found to be one foot out of the floodplain and could not be included in the project. In the process of closeout.
- >La Grange DI-71: Eight properties were purchased and demolition completed June 12, 2012. Closeout monitoring has been held and closeout paperwork is being processed.
- >Hannibal DI-72: 15 residential properties and one commercial property has been purchased. Asbestos inspections have been completed and demolition is expected to be complete by late December.
- >Jefferson City DI-73: Relocation and asbestos inspections are complete. Removal and demolition should occur next quarter for all properties. 36 total units were acquired and 23 were vacant. 2 units declined relocation assistance and 11 units accepted relocation assistance.
- >Ferguson DI-74: Working on revisions to Environmental Assessment.
- >Poplar Bluff DI-75: Environmental Assessment has been completed and Authority to use Grant Funds will be issued October 12. Offers will then be made to property owners. Funds have been drawn for engineering and exempt costs only to date until Authority to
- >Use Grant Funds has been issued.
- >University City DI-76: To date, the City has acquired 23 of 25 properties between July and December 2011. One property owner withdrew from the program the week of 7/9/12, leaving two remaining properties in the buyout program. We intend to draw down CDBG funds upon project completion. CDBG funds were used for acquisition. Other funds will be used for demolition.
- >Pettis County DI-77: Training participants began in the classroom learning specific aspects of the building trades&mdashblue print reading, estimating, safety, etc. Under the direction of technical instructors, participants moved to the Pin Oak Lodge site and began with the process of marking trees wit by putting up construction fences and working with the Parks Division personnel, which trees or limbs would be removed. Participants then moved into the realm of demolition of the existing foundation and stem walls as they would need to be removed and replaced. Participants learned how to lay out a construction site for materials as well as traffic flow for heavy equipment and material deliveries. Participants were involved in the inventorying of tools and equipment that would be used on the construction site. The instruction includes the use of backhoe, skloader, trucks, equipment trailers, etc. Each day begins with a safety focus/lesson. Participants have been involved in the demolition of fireplaces.&mdashremoving the rock for later use. As that part of the project came to a conclusion, students then began setting steel in the foundation that would later receive concrete. On the concrete foundations, students

stem walls and placed steel with the forms. Concrete was then poured and forms removed. Participants installed insulation board on the interior of the stem walls, installed steel beams and prepared for installation of the sub-floor. Concrete block walls were installed on the exterior of the stem walls for a finished look for the lodge. Chimneys are being rebuilt and the excess mortar is being removed cleaning the rock for a finished look. Numerous meetings between SFCC and the State Parks Division are scheduled and held where details of the project, project progress and budget are discussed. Participants participate in most all of these meetings as part of the learning experience of managing a construction project. As part of the estimating coursework and in association with this project, students have been reading construction drawings, specifications sheets, and developing material lists. They have been involved with discussions with the various suppliers and manufacturers. This gives the students direct experience in developing material lists and dealing with vendors, suppliers, and manufacturers.

St. Louis DI-78: A much fewer than anticipated number of clients have applied for the program. Of those who have applied, many were ineligible for a variety of reasons, e.g. exceeded the income guidelines, did not live in the property, previously completed repairs, cost of repairs exceeded program guidelines, etc. As such, in May, CDA met with the Mayor&rsquos Office and the Alderman of the ward most impacted by the tornado and devised a strategy in order to reach those who had previously not responded. Surveys were mailed out to those who had not responded to applications that were mailed at least on two previous occasions. The surveys asked whether or not repairs related to the tornado had been already completed, whether or not assistance was still needed and other eligibility questions. The surveys were due on June 8, 2012. The original intent was to hold a community meeting with the respondents so that the program could be further explained to the homeowners. However, only 18 were returned as of the end of June (several were submitted past the due date), and of five of them were not eligible to receive assistance under the program. Given that only 13 respondents appeared to meet the requirements, we decided to schedule one-on-one meetings with each of the homeowners in order to fully explain the program, review the application and answer any questions that they might have. Eleven scheduled meetings occurred, and five submitted applications that were approved. Work is currently out for bid.

>HSTCC DI-79: The HSTCC staff began the scope of work for the FY2012-13 EDA Planning Partnership Grant that will be matched with the remaining funds from this project.

>Economic Security Corporation DI-80: Completed 14 rehab projects first quarter of 2012 and 11 houses in second quarter of 2012 (compared to total of 33 projects 2011). We continue to work for acceleration of reconstruction process for our community with goal of full disaster recovery.

>Joplin DI-81: Proposed properties continue to be presented to local Building Board for designation as dangerous structures to qualify for demolition. This quarter two non-asbestos containing structures and twenty-two (22) foundations have been demolished by the city.

>Neighborhood Life House DI-82: Continued discussion regarding site location of purchased equipment is ongoing. >Duquesne 2008-DI-83: THE HSTCC continued to accept applications on behalf of the city from potential project beneficiaries. Tier 1 ER was completed by the end of the quarter, with the exception of the publication of the combined notice and submission of the RROF/C. The guidelines for the project were drafted, approved by the state and being reviewed for approval and adoption by the city.

>Joplin Area Habitat for Humanity 2008-DI-84: 21 lots have been closed on. The general contractor was procured and hired for construction of 10 homes in two separate contracts. The remaining 10 homes were started using Habitat as the general contractor. All 35 homes are under construction. All 35 homes have a selected family and are ready to move in when complete.

>St. Louis County 2008-DI-85: The Lemay Streetscape project will take place along the Lemay Ferry commercial thoroughfare from River City Blvd. to Hoffmeister Ave and on S. Broadway at the intersection of Ripa Ave. The county issued an RFQ for Architectural and Design services. 11 firms submitted proposals and a selection was made. Currently in contract negotiations to begin design work in November. ER has been completed and is under review by the state.

>Full Employment Council 2008-DI-86: Project has completed.

>2008-DI-87 thru 2008-DI-95: Awardees are executing funding agreements, and preparing job training activities.
